## Committee Volunteer Opportunities

The various LCARW committees offer a number of opportunities for members to get to know each other and to get involved in our community. Our club sponsors scholarships for graduating seniors in Montgomery ISD and Willis ISD. Our annual March luncheon honors 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade winners of the "My American Hero" essay contest with certificates and goodies provided by the club and area politicians. Members regularly volunteer at the county Republican Headquarters and participate actively in campaign activities. We also provide funds and volunteers at The Friendship Center as well as donate books to the libraries of our local elementary schools.

We encourage each of our members to volunteer for a committee that peaks your interest. Here is a bit more detail on what LCARW committees do:

- **Americanism** - The main focus of this committee is the "My American Hero" Essay contest in Montgomery/Willis ISD. Volunteers in small groups read and judge essays written by 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders. School faculty, winners and family members attend our award program in March. This is a great way to meet fellow members, and the essays are very entertaining.
- **Caring for America** - LCARW is very active in community service projects in Montgomery/Willis. Some examples from past years are (1) ringing the bell for Salvation Army; (2) Veteran donations; (3) Food Bank collection; (3) school supply donations, and (4) honoring First Responders on 9/11. If you have a heart for volunteering, this is your committee!
- **Community Engagement** - Volunteers attend festivals, fundraisers, and community events to help grow relationships with LCARW and the community. This committee needs outgoing personalities!
- **Hospitality** - This committee provides greeters at monthly meetings and other MCRP events as needed. This is a great way to get to know your fellow members and elected officials! This is another committee for outgoing, friendly faces.
- **Literacy** - Volunteers for this committee are responsible for helping set up the September Book Fair by Barnes and Noble to support Montgomery and Willis ISD in addition to county libraries.
- **Scholarships** - This committee is tasked with judging scholarship applications of High School Seniors of Montgomery and Willis ISD. The scholarships are awarded during our May general meeting.
- **Senior Americans** - LCARW volunteers reach out to Montgomery and Willis communities to show that Republican women recognize and appreciate Senior adults. Some past programs have been furnishing lunch for Seniors at the Lone Star Community Center, providing Christmas gifts to Seniors, and visiting and providing desserts to residents of Senior Centers.
- **Special Events** - Volunteers will help the committee chairman plan our annual Christmas party and other social events, as well as acting as hostesses for these events.
